Chairman Vincent Furtado called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

# 1. <u>Acceptance of minutes of the October 13, 2020 meeting</u> Mr. Nicholson motioned approval of the October 13, 2020 minutes with the correction that Mr. Jeff Furtado abstained at the last meeting due to an absence, Mr. Jeff Furtado seconded. The motion passed in a roll call vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 2 abstained (7-0-2) with Mr. Rees and Mr. Chase abstaining.

# 2. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Jeffrey Furtado had e-mailed members the Treasurer's report which included expenses from July 1, 2020 through the end of October 2020.

Treasurer Furtado reported that total payments made since July 1, 2020 totaled \$14,988.73 and total income since July 1, 2020 totaled \$5,065.93. Mr. Nicholson motioned acceptance of the Treasurer's report as presented, M. Chase seconded, all in favor on a roll call vote of 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained. (9-0-2)

### 3. Review of 342 Snipatuit Road Rochester ANR Plan

Chairman Furtado reported that the subcommittee reviewed the above referenced plan submitted by Sean McComb to construct a single-family dwelling near the parents' property. They are hoping that the BOH will require a denitrification system. Mr. Renauld has no issues with the proposed project.

Mr. Rees motioned that the MRVWSPAC issue a letter to the Rochester Planning Board on the above referenced respective project recommending favorable endorsement, Mr. Chase seconded, al in favor. The motion passed in a roll call vote of 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained (9-0-0).

4. <u>Discuss Purchase of Specific Conductance Probe for Hach Meter</u>
Mrs. Farinon explained that she received a request from Snow's Pond
Association president Michelle Kirby informing her that the self- monitoring
would be greatly enhanced if they had a conductivity (specific conductance)
probe. She said that they're already getting pH at certain depths from URI, so
this purchasing a conductivity probe would provide additional data results.
Mr. Gregory researched the cost of the unit and said it would be
approximately \$850. Mr. Charon motioned to allocate \$850 towards the
purchase of a specific conductance meter, Mr. Jeff Furtado seconded, all in
favor. The motion passed in a roll call vote of 8 in favor, 0 opposed, 0

abstained (8-0-0).

Mr. Gregory summarized efforts to purchase the dissolved oxygen probe for the Hach meter and calibration equipment. They expect to have the equipment by the end of the year.

# 6. New Business

Discussion ensued about the status of the beaver issue on the Mattapoisett River. Attorney Bailey explained that the town of Rochester has consulted with the State's fur bearing mammal biologist on options.

Mr. Chase motioned to adjourn the meeting of the MRVWSPAC at 4:00 p.m., Ms. Davis seconded, all in favor. The motion passed in a roll call vote of 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained (9-0-0).
